- On April 26, 2018, Revolut announced it had secured \$250 million in Series C financing led by DST Global
 - Existing and new investors, including Index Ventures and Ribbit Capital, also participated in this investment round
 - With this Series C, Revolut now has a valuation of \$1.7 billion, a valuation approximately 5x larger than its previous round
 - This new investment brings the total funding of the Company up to \$340 million
- Revolut intends to use the new capital to expand internationally, starting with the US, Canada, Singapore, Hong Kong and Australia in 2018
 - The Company also intends to grow its workforce, expecting to increase its headcount from 350 to 800 employees by the end of 2018
- Revolut now processes around \$1.8 billion through its platform each month
 - The Company claims it signs up between 6,000 and 8,000 new users every day
 - At almost 2 million total users, Revolut has set a goal of reaching 100 million users in the next five years

"Our focus, since we launched, has been to do everything completely opposite to traditional banks. We build world class tech that puts people back in control of their finances, we speak to our customers like humans and we're never afraid to challenge old thinking in order to innovate. To have DST Global on board is an incredible endorsement of our business strategy as we begin to expand Revolut around the world. Banking has historically avoided disruptions by technology, but that is all about to change on a big scale."

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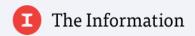
