- On January 16, 2016, JD.com, the parent company of JD Finance, announced that its subsidiary had raised \$1 billion (RMB 6.65 billion)
 - The round was led by Sequoia Capital China, China Harvest Investments and China Taiping Insurance
 - JD.com will maintain a majority stake in JD Finance
 - The Company is valued at approximately \$7.1 billion (RMR 46.65 billion) in this transaction
- JD Finance offers online financial services to companies, start-ups and individual consumers across the Chinese marketplace
 - Additionally, a partnership with Zest Finance allows JD Finance to offer credit scores to lenders, allowing them to offer credit solutions to their customers
 - Chinese businesses are able to utilize JD

















