#### **Transaction Summary**

- On October 8, 2018, Nubank, a Brazil-based digital bank, announced it has raised \$180 million in financing from Chinese internet giant, Tencent
  - Tencent invested \$90 million of new capital and acquired an additional \$90 million in partial stakes from Nubank shareholders
  - This latest financing round values the Company at \$4 billion according to TechCrunch (1)
  - The new investment brings the total capital raised by Nubank to over \$500 million
- Through the strategic partnership, Tencent will help Nubank expand and develop in areas such as payments, consumer loans, engineering and machine learning (2)
- In January 2018, Nubank received the regulatory approval to become a bank

- Nubank is a Brazilian financial services company that offers a nofee MasterCard Platinum credit card that customers can manage using their mobile phone along with a mobile bank account
  - The mobile app features real-time spending notifications, personalized categories for tracking payments and the ability to lock and unlock the credit card directly from the app
- In October 2017, Nubank announced it is now offering a free mobile bank account, NuContas, but it is currently only offered in beta mode to Brazilian residents
- Nubank generates revenue through merchant fees, foreign exchange fees for international transactions and interest on unpaid balances
- The Company's growth has been built entirely on word of mouth and social media with minimal customer acquisition costs
- Over 20 million people have applied for the card, and over 500,000 people are on the waitlist (1)


