Transaction Summary

- On March 9, 2017, Toss announced that it has raised \$48 mm in a Series C financing round that includes a strategic investment from PayPal
 - The round was led by Goodwater Capital, which also led Toss's Series B round
 - Bessemer Venture Partners, Altos Ventures and Partech Ventures also participated in the round
- The Company has raised \$76 mm to date (1)
- Toss will use the funding to expand its business beyond peer-topeer (P2P) payments into cross-border money transfers, loans other credit options and micro-insurance
- Viva Republica, doing business as Toss, is a South Korea based financial services mobile application
 - To date, Toss has processed more than \$3 bn in transactions from its 6 million registered users (1)
 - Toss has partnerships with 18 out of 19 major banks in South Korea for its payments and banking services (1)

"Before Toss, users required five passwords and around 37 clicks to transfer \$10. With Toss users need just 1 password and three steps to transfer up to KRW 500,000 (\$430) ... The market is huge and ready to embrace really great financial service but nobody is pushing forward for it ... There might be competition in the future but right now we think it's quite different. What [Kakao is] doing is more a b2b play, they want to be a basic payment system in Korea, and are acquiring merchants."




