Weidai Raises \$153 million in Series C Financing

Transaction Summary and Weidai Overview

Transaction Summary

- On May 23, 2016, Hangzhou-based peer to peer lending and microfinance company, Weidai, raised RMB1 bn (\$153 mm) in Series C financing
 - The round was led by Vision Knight Capital along with participation from China Securities and Dong Yi RI Shen Home Decoration Group
 - The Company raised RMB150 mm (\$24 mm) in its Series B round led by Hakim Information Technology in September 2015
- Weidai plans to use the funding to expand into additional lending categories such as real estate, consumer finance and supply chain finance along with further expansion into auto finance services including auto after-sale services and auto insurance
- The Company reports monthly transactions of \$235 mm as of August 2015
 - Weidai's loans are typically one-month in maturity with an interest rate of roughly 11%




