Invesco Acquires Jemstep

Transaction Overview

Transaction Overview

- On January 12, 2016, Invesco announced it had acquired Jemstep, a provider of advisor-focused digital wealth management solutions
- The news comes a few months after public speculation indicating that Invesco and State Street might move into the "robo-advisor" space in order to keep up with rivals like Vanguard, which developed its own internal "roboadvisor" platform, and BlackRock, which acquired FutureAdvisor (1)
- Jemstep's Chief Executive Officer, Kevin Cimring, and President, Simon Roy, will remain with the Company
- Terms of the transaction were not disclosed

Transaction Rationale

- Invesco plans on having its sales and service teams work with home offices and advisors to implement Jemstep's technology, which includes tracking advisor processes, viewing client data and managing risk
- Through the acquisition, Invesco will also offer advisors more than market-cap weighted indexing by providing access to a variety of professionally selected investment options across mutual funds and ETFs
- Invesco believes the acquisition will expand its advisor relationships by providing them with better digital technology for interfacing with clients

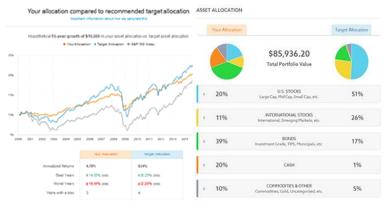

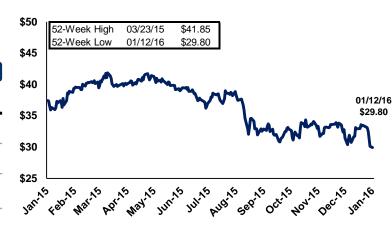

Transaction Overview and Rationale

Overview of Transaction

- On August 26, 2015, BlackRock (NYSE: BLK) announced a definitive agreement to acquire 100% of FutureAdvisor
- FutureAdvisor is a leading digital wealth management platform with technology-enabled investment advice capabilities
- BlackRock offers investment management, risk management and advisory services to institutional and retail clients worldwide and has over \$4.7tn in assets under management⁽¹⁾
- Following the transaction, FutureAdvisor will operate as a business within BlackRock Solutions ("BRS"), BlackRock's investment and risk management platform
- The transaction is expected to close in Q4 2015

Significance of Transaction

- Combines FutureAdvisor's tech-enabled advice capabilities with BRS' investment and risk management solutions
- Enables BlackRock to provide a B2B digital advice platform, which helps financial institution partners both improve their clients' investment experiences and grow advisory assets
- Empowers partners to meet the growing demand among consumers to engage with technology to gain insights on their investment portfolios
 - Demand is particularly strong among the mass-affluent, who account for ~30% of investable assets in the U.S.

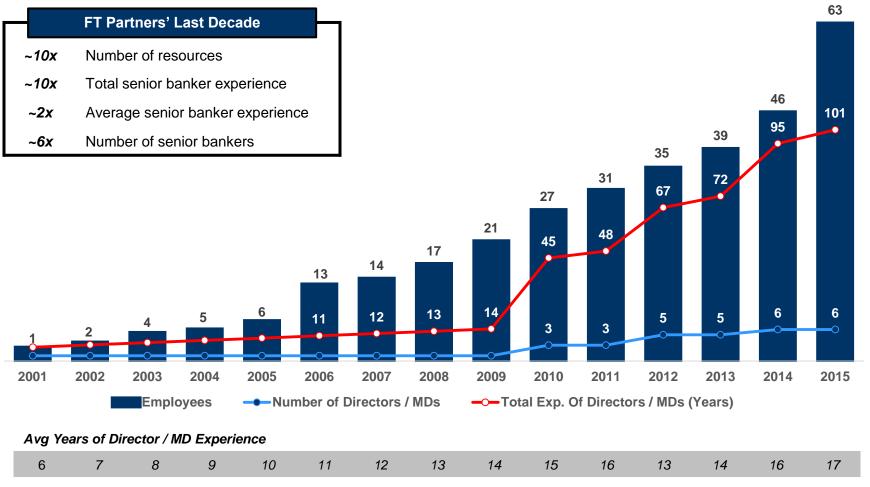
