 - The round also included participation from existing investor, Power Financial Group
 - To date, the Company has raised over \$190 million in financing
 - According to PitchBook, this round values the Company at approximately \$767 million, post money
- Wealthsimple plans to use the new capital to deepen its customer relationships by further developing its existing services and expanding into new product offerings
 - Wealthsimple also hopes to continue evolving its B2B platform for advisors and institutions as well as accelerate growth across its three markets
- Wealthsimple is a leading robo-advisor in Canada that has entered the US and UK markets, managing over \$4.5 billion for more than 150,000 clients

Overview of Transaction

- On August 26, 2015, BlackRock (NYSE: BLK) announced a definitive agreement to acquire 100% of FutureAdvisor
- FutureAdvisor is a leading digital wealth management platform with technology-enabled investment advice capabilities
- BlackRock offers investment management, risk management and advisory services to institutional and retail clients worldwide and has over \$4.7tn in assets under management
- Following the transaction, FutureAdvisor will operate as a business within BlackRock Solutions ("BRS"), BlackRock's investment and risk management platform
- The transaction is expected to close in Q4 2015


