#### **Transaction Overview**

#### **Transaction Overview**

- On November 16, 2015, Intercontinental Exchange (ICE) announced an agreement to acquire Trayport for \$650 million in ICE stock
- ICE offers a global network of clearing houses and exchanges as well as valuation and benchmark services for ETFs, financial derivatives and bonds
- Trayport offers a licensed technology platform designed for brokers that facilitates electronic and hybrid trading and execution in the OTC European energy markets
- ICE will acquire 100% of Trayport from its previous investor GFI Group (acquired by BGC Partners in March of 2015)
- The agreement was approved unanimously by the Board of Directors for both Trayport and ICE and is expected to close in Q1 of 2016

#### **Transaction Rationale**

- The acquisition will allow ICE to expand its offerings and presence in the European OTC energy markets
- Additionally, Trayport's solutions will provide customers in the OTC market a broader set of risk management and analytics solutions

#### **Valuation**

- The LTM revenue multiple for the transaction is 8.1x
- The 100% equity stake of Trayport equates to 2.5 million shares of ICE stock, as of the signing date in the agreement (ICE share price of \$261.92)

#### **ICE Commentary**

"European regulators have made clear that they do not expect OTC gas and power markets to be subject to the mandatory clearing provisions that are being applied to other commodity markets. As such, these vital markets will require continued investment as part of the European energy market evolution. In addition, with ICE's experience in managing secure technology, we are well positioned to support the continued development of these systems."

- Solution is a single trading terminal that syncs market data across all major energy markets that allows customers to better understand the broader market




