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Transaction Overview

Transaction Summary

- On February 24, 2017, consumer financial services company SoFi announced that it had raised \$500 million in Series F financing led by Silver Lake, with participation from SoftBank and GPI Capital
- SoFi plans to use the funding to introduce new product offerings – such as mobile deposit, credit and payment products, fueled by its recent acquisition of Zenbanx – and expand internationally to Australia and Canada
- The new investment round brings SoFi's total amount of equity funding raised to \$1.9 billion and reportedly values the Company at \$4.3 billion according to Bloomberg (1)

- SoFi is a consumer finance company that provides online financial services such as student loan refinancing, personal and mortgage loans, wealth management and insurance
- The Company's underwriting method focuses on graduates of top tier universities with responsible financial history and stable monthly cash flow and income
- The Company also offers career services for its members, such as professional advice, career coaching programs, entrepreneur mentoring and six-month deferment for business development
- The Company has originated \$16 billion in loans to date, generating \$1.45 bn in member savings
 - The Company funded \$8 bn in 2016, an increase from \$5 bn in 2015
- The Company currently has around 250,000 members


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Student Loan Market

Industry Overview

- As tuition costs rise for both public and private undergraduate schools, a greater number of students are resorting to student loans to finance their education
 - Average cost of education (tuition, fees and room and board) increased at a CAGR of 4.5% and 4.0%, respectively, from Academic Year 2007/2008 through Academic Year 2016/2017
- Total student loans outstanding currently exceeds \$1.4 trillion, with the amount consistently growing over the past 10 years
 - There are 44.2 million student loan borrowers, with 39% under the age of 30 (1)
- Unemployment rate of 20-24 year old college graduates has dropped from a high of 13.3% in 2011 to 3.8% at the end of 2015 ⁽²⁾, improving student loan performance


