Upgrade Raises \$48 mm in Series A Financing

Transaction Overview

Transaction Summary

- On April 6, 2017, Upgrade announced it has raised \$60 million in Series A financing
 - The Company raised \$48 million in equity and \$12 million in convertible notes, according to TechCrunch (1)
 - The round reportedly values the company at \$168 million according to an article by The New York Times, which references data from CB Insights (2)



- Upgrade simultaneously announced the launch of its personal loan product, available to consumers through an online platform
 - Loans originated through the Upgrade platform are issued by WebBank; Upgrade will acquire loans from WebBank, retain a representative portion on its balance sheets and offer whole loans for sale to institutional investors
- Upgrade plans to launch credit monitoring, alerts and education features in the coming weeks
- Jefferies is working with the Company to develop its capital markets strategy, and the investment bank also expected to participate in loan purchases
- Upgrade is also in conversations with four large asset managers to provide funding for loans originated on the platform (3)

- Upgrade operates an online consumer marketplace lending platform that offers unsecured consumer loans as well as tools that help consumers understand and monitor their credit
- Operating through a marketplace lending model, Upgrade connects borrowers looking for a loan with investors willing to provide capital
- The founding team includes Renaud Laplanche and Soul Htite, co-founders of Lending Club - an early pioneer of the marketplace lending model, which went public in 2014
 - Soul Htite also founded Dianrong, one of the largest marketplace lending platforms in China
- Unlike Lending Club, which allowed retail investors to fund loans offered on the platform, the Company is working exclusively with institutional investors (1)


