- On September 6, 2018 Monese announced it has raised \$60 million in Series B financing led by Kinnevik
 - Additional investors in the round include Paypal, Augmentum FinTech, International Airlines Group (investing for its data loyalty and data business arm Avios Group), and Investec's INVC Fund
- Launched in 2015, UK-based Monese provides mobile-based current accounts and accompanying debit cards
 - The Company services almost 600,000 customers
 - The Company has experienced new monthly customer growth of 3x since the end of 2017
- The Company intends to use the funds for product development and international expansion
 - Monese also plans to hire an additional 100 employees across its existing UK and Estonian offices as well as a third new office in Portugal by the end of the year




