- On June 10, 2019, cloud-based digital banking solutions provider Alkami Technology announced it had raised \$55 million in a Series E funding round
 - Existing investors General Atlantic and MissionOG led the round
 - Other existing investors S3 Ventures and Argonaut Private Equity also participated in the round
 - To date, Alkami has raised over \$225 million in funding
- Alkami provides a digital banking platform for more than 130 financial institutions across the United States, and its clients have over 6 million registered users on the platform
- The Company plans to use the latest funds to accelerate investments in its cloud solutions for U.S. banks and credit unions (1)
 - Alkami's platform gives traditional institutions the tools to drive their digital strategies in a space increasingly under pressure from larger banks and newer FinTech entrants ⁽¹⁾
- After its previous capital raise (\$70 million Series D financing in 2018), Alkami expanded its team across all departments and doubled its office space at its Plano headquarters (1)
