Transaction Summary

- On August 24, 2017, Blend announced it had secured \$100 million in Series D financing led by Greylock Partners with participation from Emergence Capital, 8VC, Lightspeed Venture Partners and Nyca Partners
 - According to the Wall Street Journal, the latest financing round will value the Company at approximately \$500 million (1)
 - This Series D round brings the total amount of funding up to \$166 million
- Blend intends to use the new capital to expand into other forms of consumer credit and further develop technology to automate other stages of the home loan process
- In parallel with the fundraise announcement, Blend announced it had signed Wells Fargo and U.S. Bancorp as clients
 - The partnership with Blend will enable the two banks to better compete against other FinTech offerings



 U.S. Bank stated the relationship with Blend can potentially shave four to five days off the loan process, which averages about six weeks (1)



 Wells Fargo has "... never chosen a startup for a project of this size and scale before." The bank intends to roll out Blend's offering across its banking footprint in 2018 ⁽¹⁾

"We're [now] a team of nearly 200 people and are working with 30 financial institutions to power a more frictionless, accessible, and compliant home lending ecosystem for their consumers. We're bringing consumers to the forefront of the lending process instead of having them adapt to it as they have in the past. The industry is evolving, changing, growing, and improving, and as drivers of that, we need to do the same.

And this is just the beginning. The opportunity for our technology in the \$40+ trillion consumer lending market is huge, but the industry won't change overnight.
