- On April 11, 2016, AssetMark announced that it had entered into an agreement to be acquired by Huatai Securities for \$780 mm
 - The transaction is expected to close by the end of 2016 and is subject to customary closing conditions
- AssetMark is a provider of investment and consulting solutions designed for financial advisors and their clients
- Huatai Securities, based in China, is a broadly diversified financial services company that provides brokerage and wealth management services, investment banking services and asset management, investment and trading services to investors
- Prior to being acquired by Huatai, AssetMark was owned by two private equity firms, Aquiline Capital Partners and Genstar Capital
- After the transaction is completed, Huatai plans to keep AssetMark operating independently with the same leadership team, sales and growth strategy and brand name
- AssetMark plans to continue developing its technology and investment solutions, including releasing a new product – Investing Evolved, which is a portfolio development tool designed to help advisors meet the needs of their clients




