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General Atlantic Increases Stake in XP Investimentos to 49%

Transaction Overview

Transaction Summary

- On April 15, 2016, General Atlantic agreed to acquire an additional 10% stake in XP Investimentos ("XP") from Actis
 - This was the last of Actis' stake in XP, so the Company has completely exited XP
- General Atlantic will also purchase shares in a primary offering from the Company
- Prior to the transactions, General Atlantic owned a 33% stake
- Upon closing of both deals, General Atlantic will own 49% of XP
- General Atlantic will pay a total of R\$450 mm (~\$130 mm) for both transactions; R\$300 mm (~\$84 mm) to Actis and R\$150 mm (~\$46 mm) to XP Investimentos
- This transaction increases the equity book value of XP to more than R\$800 mm (~\$224 mm)
- Despite the sensitive financial conditions in Brazil, XP has continued to perform resiliently due to a large base of investors to target as customers
- XP intends to advance its expansion plan and list the company on an exchange through an IPO⁽¹⁾
