- On May 31, 2016, The Carlyle Group announced that it had made an approximately \$400 mm minority investment in ION Investment Group, a global provider of software to financial institutions and corporations focused on trading, risk management and treasury management solutions
 - Equity from this transaction came primarily from Carlyle Partners VI, a \$13 bn fund that is part of Carlyle's Corporate Private Equity segment
- Carlyle's investment in ION is a continuation of Carlyle's long-term global commitment to Technology, Media and Telecom (TMT)
 - Carlyle has invested more than \$22 bn of equity in the TMT space since inception
- Following this transaction, Carlyle's Renee James and Cam Dyer will join ION's board of directors
- Carlyle's Corporate Private Equity Segments has assets under management of \$61 bn, 279 investment professionals, 32 active funds worldwide and more than 275 active investments as of March 31, 2016


