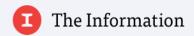

Ion Acquires Fidessa for Approximately \$2.1 billion

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Transaction Summary

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- On April 20, 2018, Ion announced it has agreed to acquire Fidessa (LSE:FDSA) for £1.5 billion (approximately \$2.1 billion) in cash
 - Ion offered Fidessa £38.703 per share
 - Registered Fidessa shareholders will receive £39.50 per share in total, including a 79.7 pence dividend to be paid in June
- Previously, Temenos (SWT:TEMN) had entered into a definitive agreement to acquire Fidessa (LSE:FDSA) on February 21, 2018
 - Temenos had offered Fidessa £35.67 per share
- SS&C, which also approached Fidessa, declined to counter-bid
- Ion's offer has received support from Fidessa shareholders who hold about 25.1% of the shares in the company
 - This includes the 4% owned by activist investor Elliot International I P and Elliot Associates I P


