#### **Transaction Summary**

- On November 29, 2017, Euronext (ENXTPA:ENX) announced its acquisition of 100% of The Irish Stock Exchange ("ISE") for €137 million (1) or approximately \$160 million
  - The transaction is subject to regulatory approvals and is expected to close in Q1 2018
- The transaction creates a leading global player in debt and fund listings, combining the listing expertise of ISE with the traded markets expertise of Euronext
- Additionally, it expands Euronext's federal model and creates a pan-European global debt, fund and ETF listing venue, with Ireland being Euronext's sixth core European country alongside France, Netherlands, Belgium, Portugal and the UK
- The combination of the two exchanges will create more growth opportunities and increased efficiency through:
  - ISE's positioning to take advantage of the post-Brexit opportunities
  - Integrated federal governance
  - The integration of trading platforms, market data and support functions













### **Net Income / % Margin**
