- On September 18, 2018, Trumid announced it has raised \$53 million in financing led by Singapore Exchange (SGX:S68) ("SGX")
 - Deutsche Börse Group, an existing investor, also participated in the round
- Launched in 2014, Trumid brings efficiency to credit trading by matching buyers and sellers in the bond market
 - The Company has a large and diverse user network of 400 buyside and sell-side institutions
 - The Company's daily trading volume in 2Q18 was 3x higher than in 2Q17
 - More traders have utilized the platform each month in 2018 since the fourth quarter of 2017
- The partnership allows Trumid access to the Asian market by utilizing SGX's regional expertise and footprint
 - The Company will use the capital to further scale its US corporate bond business and support the expansion of protocols, products, and geographies
