 - Additional investors in the round include Proparco,
 Finnfund, Vostok Emerging Finance, Gemcorp Financial and LeapFrog Investments
 - The latest round brings the Company's total financing to \$90 million
- Launched in 2014, South African-based Jumo provides a technology platform for operating inclusive mobile financial services marketplaces
- The Company intends to use the funds to expand its services into high-growth Asian markets, as well as developing more savings products and increasing bank partnerships within existing markets (1)
 - The Company currently serves clients across Kenya, Uganda, Tanzania, Rwanda, Ghana, and Zambia, and recently expanded its Asian operations with new offices in Pakistan and Singapore


