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### **Transaction Overview**

### **Transaction Summary**

- On July 12, 2018, JD Finance announced it has signed binding agreements with investors to raise 13 billion yuan (~\$2 billion) in financing
  - The financing is expected to close in Q3 2018
- Participating investors in this round include CICC Capital, China Securities, Citic Capital and BOCGI
- The transaction values JD Finance at approximately 133 billion yuan (~\$19.8 billion) according to Reuters (1)
  - The valuation is more than 2x the approximately 60 billion yuan (~\$9 billion) that JD Finance was estimated to be worth after it was spun off from JD.com, in March of 2017 <sup>(1)</sup> (view details of the spin-off transaction here)
- The Company plans to use the funds to invest in domestic financial institutions and buy securities and banking licenses



- JD Finance is the financial affiliate of Chinese eCommerce giant, JD.com (the Company was spun-off into a separate entity in March 2017)
- The Company provides online financial services to individuals, start-ups and other businesses
  - Services offered to consumers include securities and investments, short-term consumer credit and insurance products
  - Services offered to businesses include crowdfunding, small business loans, supply chain financing and cash management
- In June 2015, the Company launched a joint venture with ZestFinance, combining JD.com's consumer data with ZestFinance's underwriting engine to offer credit services for Chinese consumers
- In January 2017, the Company partnered with China UnionPay to develop online payment solutions, co-branded credit cards and rural financing programs

### FT Partners Advises GreenSky on its \$1 billion Initial Public Offering

#### Overview of Transaction

- On May 23, 2018, GreenSky (Nasdaq: GSKY) priced its IPO at \$23 per share, raising approximately \$1.01 billion
- Due to strong demand, the deal priced at the high end of the initial \$21 \$23 filing range and the number of shares was increased by 3.9 million, or 11%
- GreenSky will use the IPO proceeds to purchase Holdco units and Class A common stock from its CEO and other officers as well as early equity investors
- GreenSky is a leading FinTech company that powers commerce at the point of sale; the Company's technology platform facilitates merchants sales, while reducing the friction, and improving the economics, associated with a consumer making a purchase and a bank extending financing for that purchase
  - GreenSky has approximately 12,000 active merchants on its platform and the Company has enabled 1.7 million consumers to finance over \$12 billion of transactions since its inception through March 31, 2018

### **Significance of Transaction**

- GreenSky's IPO is the largest U.S. Technology IPO of 2018 and is also the largest U.S. FinTech IPO in over two years<sup>1</sup>
- This transaction further supports FT Partners' continued success advising leading FinTech growth companies and also highlights the long-term nature of many of the Firm's advisory relationships

#### FT Partners' Role

- FT Partners served as IPO Advisor to GreenSky on this transaction
- FT Partners previously advised GreenSky on its \$300 million investment by TPG, Iconiq, Wellington, and DST in 2014, its \$2 billion Ioan purchase agreement and \$50 million investment by Fifth Third Bank in 2016, and its \$200 million investment by PIMCO in 2017
