Ygrene Raises \$95 million in Financing

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Transaction Summary

- Ygrene Energy Fund (aka YgreneWorks) provides home improvement financing for energy efficiency upgrades
- On December 21, 2016, the Company announced it had raised \$95 million in funding from Lightyear Capital
- Ygrene will use the funding to continue its growth and expand into new markets
- The round brings the Company's combined assets and operating capital raised to over \$1 billion
- Ygrene has approved more than \$1.85 billion in financing volume for home and business owners
 - The projects financed have created over 9,000 local jobs and an estimated \$1.5 billion in annual economic stimulus

Recent News

- On November 15, 2016, the Company announced it had completed a \$184 million public asset-backed security offering, which was the industry's first AAA-rated PACE financing asset
- On November 10, 2016, the Company announced it had secured a \$30 million financing facility from the New Energy Capital Infrastructure Credit Fund
- On May 25, 2016, the Company announced it had secured a \$250 million revolving credit facility


