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- On January 24, 2018, Dianrong announced it had raised an additional \$70 million in an extension of its Series D financing led by ORIX Asia Capital, a wholly-owned investment vehicle of ORIX Corporation
 - CLSA, the international platform of Citic Securities (China's largest investment bank), also participated in the round
- This \$70 million investment follows Dianrong's original Series D of \$220 million in August 2017
 - The \$220 million investment round was led by GIC with participation from CMIG Leasing and Simone Investment Managers


