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Equiniti Acquires Wells Fargo Shareowner Services for \$227 mm

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Transaction Summary





Transaction Summary

- On July 13, 2017, Equiniti (LSE:EQN) announced it had agreed to acquire Wells Fargo Shareowner Services ("WFSS") for \$227 million
 - Because of the large scale of the transaction, the acquisition is conditional on Equiniti's shareholder approval at a General Meeting, which is expected to be held in September 2017
 - The acquisition is expected to close in Q4 2017 or Q1 2018, after the carve out of WFSS and regulatory approval
- By acquiring WFSS, which is the third largest U.S. share registrar by number of clients, Equiniti will become a multinational share registration and services business
 - Through the acquisition, Equiniti will be able to provide a broader range of services to its clients
 - Equiniti and WFSS have an excellent strategic fit and share direct core competencies
- Equiniti expects the acquisition to be financially attractive for its shareholders
 - Expected to be strongly earnings accretive in the first full ownership year, growing to double digit earnings accretive by the end of the second ownership year
 - Return on invested capital (ROIC) is expected to exceed the weighted average cost of capital (WACC) in the second year of ownership
 - Expected cost synergies of at least \$10 million
- The acquisition will be financed from a fully underwritten rights issue of \$160 million and a \$155 million of fully underwritten new debt facilities











Net Income / % Margin

Diluted EPS / % Growth








