- On September 15, 2016, Ripple announced it raised \$55 million in a Series B funding round
 - Participants in the round include Standard Chartered, Accenture Ventures, SCB Digital Ventures, Siam Commercial Bank, SBI Holdings, Santander Innoventures, CME Group, Seagate Technology and Venture 51
- Ripple simultaneously announced the addition of several global banks to its network
- The Company will use the funds to accelerate its rapid customer growth, pursue strategic partnerships and grow the team internationally
