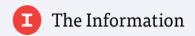

Transaction Summary

- On June 19, 2018, Brex announced it had secured \$50 million in Series B financing
- Ribbit Capital, Y Combinator, PayPal founders Peter Thiel and Max Levchin, Yuri Milner of DST Global, Chase Coleman of Tiger Global, and former Visa CEO Carl Pascarella participated in the financing round
- The new funding brings Brex's total capital raised to \$57 million
- This funding will partially go towards expanding the Company's 30 person team and towards marketing efforts
 - The Company has a goal of reaching \$300 million in spending on its corporate cards this year and \$1.5 billion by the end of 2019
 - Majority of the financing will provide a support cushion for the risks of providing credit to early stage startups
- Brex provides corporate credit cards to startups through an online application
 - The Company currently has 1,000 users from companies including SoFi, Affirm and LendingHome
 - Initially, the Company is only targeting startups as customers, but will later move toward more established tech firms, and then to companies across all industries

- Brex is a provider of a corporate credit card intended to simplify the process of paying business expenses
 - The Company's credit card controls the expenses and features of different companies without security deposit or personal guarantee
 - It also integrates directly with annual reports by eliminating annual fees, issuance fees and interest charges, enabling employees to protect their personal credit without restricting their capital
- Brex helps startups of all sizes (from recently incorporated to later-stage companies) to instantly get a credit card that has 20x higher limits
- Brex approves companies for credit cards based on investors, cash balance and spending patterns and then set limits accordingly
- The Company makes money two ways:
 - By charging \$5 per user per year, and by charging transaction fees on every purchase
