- On April 30, 2019, UiPath announced that it has raised \$568 million in Series D financing led by Coatue Management
 - Dragoneer, Wellington, Sands Capital, funds and accounts advised by T. Rowe Price Associates, Accel, CapitalG, Sequoia, IVP, and Madrona Venture Group also participated in the round
- The Company expects to use the funding to expand UiPath's focus into front-office and customer-facing areas, such as customer support and sales (1)
 - UiPath has been focused on internal and back-office tasks, such as accounting, human resources paperwork, and claims processing
- In the last two years UiPath has...
 - Grown annual recurring revenue from \$8 million to more than \$200 million
 - Raised over \$970 million in financing
 - Increased its valuation from \$110 million to over \$7 billion


