Transaction Summary

- On July 3, 2018, Australia-based Airwallex announced that it has secured \$80 million in Series B financing
- The round was led by existing investors Tencent and Sequoia China, with participation from China's Hillhouse, Horizons Ventures, Central Capital Ventura (BCA), and Australia's Square Peg
- The new funding brings Airwallex's total capital raised to \$102 million
- With this funding, the Company will expand its business in Europe and North America, while maintaining its focus on Hong Kong and Southeast Asia
 - The Company will also be expanding its product range
- Airwallex is in the process of applying for three additional licenses: 1) a virtual banking license in Hong Kong, 2) a third-party payment license in mainland China, and 3) a cross-border Chinese yuan license
 - The Company intends to offer working capital loans to SMEs to help them grow


