

Transaction Overview

Transaction Overview

- On April 23, 2015 Covestor announced that it has entered into an agreement to be acquired by Interactive Brokers Group
 - The deal has been approved by the boards of both companies and it is expected to close in the second guarter of 2015
 - Terms of the acquisition were not disclosed
- Covestor is an online investing marketplace that offers both active and passive investment options while Interactive Brokers is the largest U.S. electronic broker as measured by daily average revenue trades
 - Covestor's investors include Union Square Ventures, Spark Capital, Amadeus Capital and Bay Partners
- This transaction follows a flurry of M&A activity in the online personal wealth management space including Fidelity Investments' purchase of eMoney Advisor, Northwestern Mutual's acquisition of LearnVest and Envestnet's acquisition of Upside; in addition, as detailed on page 5, a number of companies in the space have recently conducted large capital raises including Acorns, Betterment, Wealthfront, Personal Capital, Motif and Nutmeg, among others

Transaction Rationale

- This transaction helps solidify Interactive Brokers' position as a leading electronic trading and investor platform serving consumers, wealth advisors and money managers
- The deal will expand Interactive Brokers' capabilities in building a marketplace that brings together multiple market constituents while offering additional products and services
- By joining with Interactive Brokers, Covestor will be able to leverage Interactive Brokers' large customer base and rapidly add more portfolio managers to Covestor's marketplace, provide additional asset classes to clients and expand its offerings globally




