Tent Checks

Line Monitors will call tent checks at their discretion. The sounding of the bullhorn will signal a check. Please gather at your tent first and then make your way as a group to check in with a Line Monitor by the Krzyzewskiville sign.

Missed Checks

Each tent is allowed one missed check per tenting period. Sustaining two missed checks in a tenting period will result in the tent being bumped to the end of the line.

If a wait list has been formed, the tent will be moved to the end of the wait list. The first tent on the wait list will then become the last tent in K-Ville.

Personal Checks

Personal Checks occur in the days leading up to the Carolina game. Five checks will be called over a two-night period. Tenters must make three of the five checks to obtain a wristband for the Carolina game. This year's Personal Checks will be on **Friday, February 23rd, 2018 and Saturday, February 24th, 2018.**

Safety and Etiquette

Tenters are responsible for ensuring the safety of all personal belongings and the cleanup of all items brought into K-Ville. TROSA will clean K-Ville once undergraduate doors open for each game. Personal items left unattended at this time are subject to removal without warning.

Body painting should be confined to soft surfaces only. No items may be plugged into a tent with any power strip or extension cord. No portable generators may be used in K-Ville. Flame-retardant tents and tarps must be used.

Carolina Walk-Up Line

Students who choose not to tent or are on the tenting wait list may form a walk-up line for the Carolina game. We do not guarantee admission to any student in the walk-up line. The walk-up line will be admitted after all tenters have been admitted.

Students in the Carolina walk-up line must join the line in groups of two. One person must represent the group at all times.

Grace will be given to the Carolina walk-up line for the first thirty minutes of every third hour beginning at 9:00AM with the last grace period ending at 12:30AM.

Grace

A grace period may be announced in which no tent checks will be called. During grace, tenters need not be on duty in K-Ville.

Grace shall be given on the following occasions:

- ▶ For one hour after a tent check is completed.
- ▶ Two hours before and after a men's or women's home basketball game.
- ▶ One hour before and after a men's or women's away basketball game.
- ▶ For the duration of a severe thunderstorm warning, flood warning, tornado warning, or any period with sustained winds in excess of thirty miles per hour or lightning within a six-mile radius.
- ▶ For the duration of a period with temperatures falling below twenty-five degrees Fahrenheit.
- ▶ For the duration of a period with more than two inches of accumulated snow or any accumulated ice.
- ▶ At any time for any length at the discretion of the Head Line Monitor

Walk-Up Line Policy Overview

Group Registration

Students should line up in groups. Only one-third of a group must be present in K-Ville at any particular time.

To register a group, one-third of the group members must be present in K-Ville. Students should locate the Registration Table in front of Cameron Indoor to register their group in line. Each student must present a DukeCard to register.

If no Line Monitor is immediately present, please form a line in front of the registration table and wait – a Line Monitor will go through the line and register groups on the sidewalk prior to those who are roaming. Rounding Up

For group sizes that are multiples of three, figuring out the number of people needed at any time in K-Ville is math so basic a Carolina student could do it: just divide by three!

For uneven groups, we employ a policy of rounding up to the nearest multiple of three when calculating group requirements. If your group size is not a multiple of three, round up to the next multiple of three and divide to calculate your required group representation.

Line Checks

Line Monitors occasionally conduct line checks to ensure that each group has the required number of people representing it.

A Line Check will be signaled with the sounding of a bullhorn siren. Tents should assemble in group order on the sidewalk and should present a DukeCard to verify their ID.

Missing a Line Check

Missing a line check for any reason will result in a group being bumped to the end of the line. If you feel a miss has been assigned in error, please contact the Head Line Monitors to discuss your circumstances.

Wristbanding

For fire safety reasons, a paper wristband is required in addition to a DukeCard to enter Cameron Indoor Stadium.

Line Monitors will distribute wristbands at the time of registration for those group who register on game day. Students who do not have a wristband for any reason on game day should obtain one at the Registration Table.

The line will assemble on the sidewalk in group order two hours prior to tip-off.

Entry

Undergraduate doors to Cameron Indoor open one and one-half hours before tip-off. Students will be admitted to Cameron in group order at that time. Students should have their DukeCard and wristband ready and visible to ensure fast admission.

Once in Section 17, please be mindful of students who have yet to be admitted and squish close to your fellow Crazies. This will allow the maximum number of students to be admitted each game.

Big Game Walk-Up Line Policy

Certain walk-up line games are in higher demand due to the nature of the opponent. For these games, a ranked walk-up line policy will be announced.

Big Game walk-up line policy differs from standard walk-up line policy in one way: the use of tents is allowed owing to the anticipation of longer wait times.

Group sizing, representation requirements for each group, and all other policies and procedures given in the standard walk-up line policy still apply. The use of tents for Big Game walk-up line games in no way relates to tenting for the Carolina game. A group's position in the line for Carolina does not dictate their position in line for any other game.
