Revolutionising the industry, this cutting-edge process ensures leading levels of speed, unparalleled health and safety standards, and the ability to automate intricate processes like brick slip corner and brick slip groove cutting.

The new brick slips centre at Nostell is progressing in two key phases. Phase one is nearing completion and focuses on driving pace and scale of brick slips through automation using the first of its kind technology here in the UK. Phase two, focuses on even more advanced technology which will significantly expand the brick slips product range offering from 2025 onwards. The latter phase is a fundamental step in Istock's journey to net zero.

At full capacity, the factory is capable of manufacturing more than 50 million brick slips per year.

The plant will open in two phases:

Phase 1 - Automated facility to produce slips from bricks, making Istock the largest brick slip manufacturer in the UK, including brick slip corners - a provision many manufacturers lack.

CASE STUDY

SOUTHMERE VILLAGE

Southmere Village is the first phase of the South Thamesmead and Abbey Wood Housing zone - one of the biggest regeneration projects in the UK. This specific phase delivered 525 homes, a library, and a new civic square. In doing so it created a coherent community with affordable accommodation.

Focusing on connectivity, community and character, the design for Southmere Village focuses on strengthening a linear connection from Abbey Wood Station to Southmere Lake and beyond. A new laneway – Southmere Lane – meanders across the urban grid and forms an enlivened sequence of streets, squares and active frontages. These create a real sense of place.

The new civic square acts as the focal point. Five-storey buildings frame the north, south and western sides of the square helping to clearly define this significant space. The blocks around the square each have their own distinctive character but are tied together through a uniform articulation of facades.

DAVENPORT PARK APARTMENTS, STOCKPORT

Formerly a run-down hotel, Davenport Park Apartments provide modern and stylish accommodation over six storeys in a practical and beautiful location. The 39 one and two-bed units are situated on the border of Davenport Park Conservation area but also close to Stockport town centre and Davenport Train Station.

Designed by local architects Cartwright and Gross, the scheme very much responds to the local urban fabric, taking inspiration from the materials, proportions and details of the local vernacular. A simple palette of materials was used to create a modern look that complements its surroundings, avoids a pastiche, and enhances the character of the area.

The design adopts key design cues such as horizontal banding, subtle variations in material tone, deep punched reveals, and façade relief to reflect the local character and urban grain whilst retaining its own distinctiveness.

Red facing bricks - Audley Red Mixture plus faced on bed solids and cut bricks - are central to the concept. The brickwork is a constant throughout the scheme and employs a variety of brickwork details and sills to create a simple, timeless design.

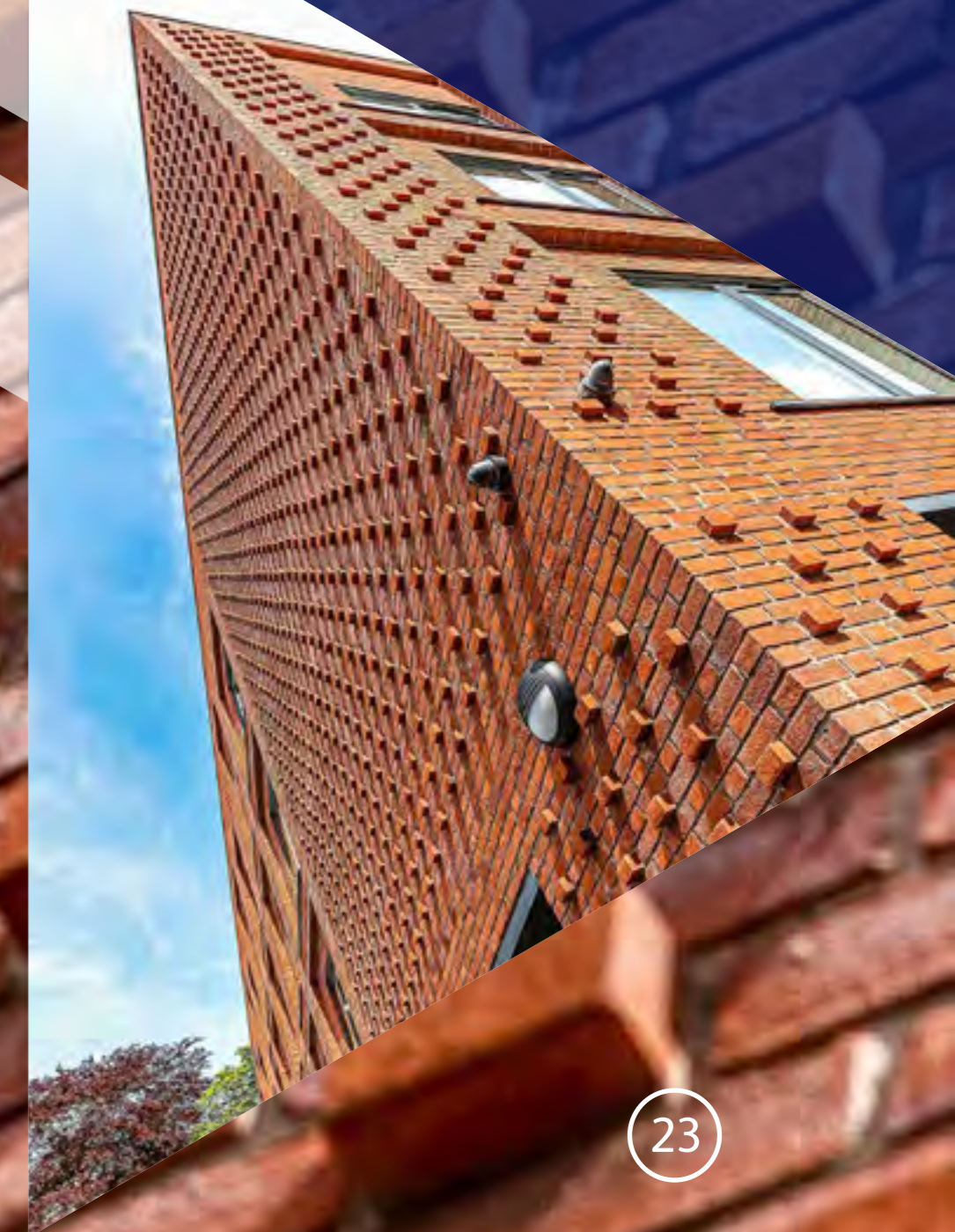

THE CONCEPT

Stood astride an existing London stock brick wall and incorporating a range of brick bonding styles, including a unique vertically-bonded structural wall, Southwark Brick House in Bermondsey is a showcase for this highly versatile building material.

The new build three-bedroom house, designed and project-managed by Satish Jassal Architects, comprises two floors and a basement level spread across two brick wings accessed via a central staircase.

The end of terrace property is positioned on the site of a former car garage, in Thorburn Square conservation area, a residential neighbourhood typical of Southwark, characterised by historic terraces and more modern apartments.

THE CONCEPT

10 Brindley Place, Birmingham, is an architectural feat of beauty with its varying forms of textures and bond patterns in the brickwork, formed together with Istock's Leicester Grey Stock, Atlas Dark Grey and Blue Glazed bricks.

It is also a testament the greatness of retrofitting our existing buildings for improved performance.

The exceptional £40m back-to-the-frame retrofit transformation of 10 Brindley Place – Birmingham's largest office refurbishment scheme, achieved an EPC A rating exceeding Government requirements for 2030 with 65% annual operational energy saving. The design drew on thermal insulation, air tightness, glazing ratios, and glass specifications to reduce heating and cooling demands, thereby saving energy, operational costs, and carbon. The specification of Istock Futures and Ash & Lacy's MechSlip

provided a completely new energy efficient external façade system clad in a brick slip, which is a major contributor to the elevated EPC A rating.

Every year in the UK, 50,000 buildings are demolished. And of the 200,000 tonnes of waste that are produced each year as a nation, nearly two-thirds is construction waste, according to the Architects' Journal's RetroFirst campaign.

Wellington House is a brand-new retail and commercial space, located in the heart of Wimbledon's commercial district. The subject of major investment to help regenerate what had been a tired building, the project, spearheaded by London architectural studio MATT Architecture, entailed a wholesale redevelopment. This has transformed Wellington House into one of the most aesthetically arresting properties in central Wimbledon.

The aesthetic of the building was central from the outset of the project. Situated on a prominent corner block, Wellington House is an important local landmark.

Well-matched to existing brickwork in the area, Ibstock's Berkshire Orange was used to great effect across Wellington House – affording the property a classic, yet distinctly contemporary, finish. What's more, both standard and curved variants of the Berkshire Orange were used, which enabled the bricks to be laid in a curve – a primary consideration given the unique location of the building.

The new facade of Wellington House combines the iconic orange brickwork with green glazed ceramics, which brings to mind the image of a classic Victorian corner pub. The end result is an incredible building that is in keeping with, yet enhancing, the local area's aesthetics. Indeed, the finished project has proven so popular that Wellington House was chosen as the cover image for the 'Living With Beauty' report, published this year by the Government's Building Better, Building Beautiful Commission.
