Requirements...

The apprenticeship programme lays the foundations of engineering expertise using mathematics and science principles gained at GCSE. So to be considered, you will need a minimum of three GCSEs or equivalent at grade C or above, including Mathematics, English Language and Science; an ICT qualification would also be advantageous. You need to be a practical "hands-on" person who can demonstrate a positive approach to work, participate in a team environment and be able to use your own initiative.

What's in it for you?

As well as training and qualifications, you will be paid a competitive rate of pay, that has the potential to grow as you gain more experience and you will also be eligible for benefits which include a defined contribution pension scheme. All your accommodation and travel expenses at MAKE UK will be paid for and we will encourage your continued professional development after you have qualified.

Where could it take you?

At the end of your apprenticeship you will be in an ideal position to develop your career. If you want to progress up the career ladder you could take on people management responsibilities and develop into an Engineering Manager, or you could choose a technical route and take on extra duties and responsibilities for example as a Process Improvement Engineer. It doesn't have to stop there, your skills, drive and determination will open up many exciting opportunities within Ibstock plc.







The Ibstock Engineering Apprenticeship Scheme is a four-year programme, which focuses on giving our apprentices the skills required to maintain and improve our factories:







FIRST YEAR RESIDENTI



Our apprenticeship programme combines study at MAKE UK Engineering Training School in Birmingham, with on-the-job learning with an experienced mentor in either electrical or mechanical engineering at the factory.

You will undertake the Engineering Technician – Mechatronics Maintenance Technician Level 3 Apprenticeship, which will provide you with the following accredited qualifications:

- Level 2 Diploma in Advanced Manufacturing Engineering (Foundation Competence)
- Level 3 Diploma in Advanced Manufacturing Engineering (Development Competence)
- Level 3 BTEC Diploma in Advanced Manufacturing Engineering (Development Knowledge)

- 18th Edition Wiring Regulations (electrical apprentices only)
- LEEA Accredited Lifting and Slinging
- Siemens S7 PLC course (electrical apprentices only)

During the first year you will attend MAKE UK Training School full time studying the BTEC Level 3 together with hands-on practical activities to complete your Level 2 Diploma. This first year will require you to stay in Birmingham during term time. (All travel and hotel costs are covered by Ibstock plc).

Once you have passed the Gateway Assessment you progress into your second year which is based at the factory with block release to the Training School to continue with your BTEC Level 3 Diploma.

During your third and fourth year you will be based in the factory putting your newly gained skills and knowledge into practice and completing your Level 3 Diploma.

The final year also includes your End-Point Assessment which once successfully completed leads to your new role within Ibstock plc as a qualified mechanical or electrical engineer.
