Care was taken to bring back to New Zealand the archives created by the First New Zealand Expeditionary Force. It was intended to use them in writing official histories. Some regimental histories were written, but interest faded and little was accomplished. All records of significance appear to have been brought back, the most important being the war diaries of each unit. Other records collected include routine and operation of orders, correspondence files, and various rolls and lists. Expeditionary force archives include not only the papers of headquarters, army corps, division and ancillary units, but also those of troop transports and the Samoan Force. A section of headquarters was specifically formed to collect records and sort them into some kind of order. Efforts were made to collect supplementary background material as well. War diaries of units which fought along side New Zealand forces were copied and relevant government administrative documents obtained.

The archives reached New Zealand intact and were initially adequately stored. Unfortunately the building housing them, Mount Cook barracks, was demolished and no provision was made for their preservation. They were in fact destined for the tip when Dr G.H. Scholefield and Mr A.D. MacIntosh discovered the disaster and tried to salvage what they could. They, however, were only able to save a small part of the total volume. It has been estimated that only some ten per cent of the total, excluding war diaries, was saved. The archives were kept in Base Records until transfer to Archives in 1960, though some were used by the War History Branch. The group was subsequently supplemented by a collection of First World War maps from the Army Department and three series of deposited papers.

The records of the expeditionary force headquarters, the Australian and New Zealand Army Corps, and the New Zealand Division had properly organised record systems, but most subordinate formations usually had no system, order depending on the initiative of adjutants and quartermasters. All units, however, were instructed to keep formal war diaries, though not all did so. Most of these are extant and form the only coherent set of papers in the archive group. Only fragments of the divisional and other record systems have survived, and of the lower formations, only oddments of routine orders, correspondence and memoranda, circulars and instructions, messages and notes.

In arranging the papers a system was devised based largely on that used for the 2NZEF archives. Units were numbered according to the order of battle. No single order of battle, however, exists. It was revised as organisational changes were made, and non-divisional units were not included. In drawing up an order certain principles were followed and these have been used to arrive at a coherent arrangement. Each unit has been made a separate series and various classes of records produced by them comprise the subseries. The classes include: war diaries, routine and non-operational orders, registered and unregistered files, miscellaneous correspondence, memoranda and notes, and papers of non-unit origin. The 2NZEF classification has been departed from in that each class of material has not been given a fixed sub-series number, and no attempt has been made to draw up a comprehensive classification for supplementary records. The surviving unit records were not numerous or diverse enough to warrant special subseries, apart from the war diaries. Nor was supplementary material so voluminous as to require more than ten series to accommodate it.

and papers were kept in some order. The 2NZEF division serving in the Pacific Islands and the New Zealand defence units records, however, though organised adequately, do not appear to have kept strictly to the order of battle. The 2NZEF Archive Section took custody and organised all war records. These were then transferred to the War History Branch in 1947. The branch used the archives, together with papers it collected to write official histories of the war. After the task was complete they were transferred to Archives. All the papers collected or created by the branch in its work on the histories and transferred to Archives has been listed in the one group, although the semi-official papers of the Editor in Chief, Sir Howard Kippenberger, have been placed in the archives of Internal Affairs. The records of Japan Force were transferred by the Army to the Branch, which devised a classification system and arranged them. Subsequently the Korea Force records were taken over and arranged. More recently, however, the records of Malaya Force were sent by the Army direct to National Archives, and have been arranged for inclusion in the war archive group.

The supplementary material comprises four sub-groups: maps of theatres of war; New Zealand Army General Staff and administrative papers; copies of war diaries of non-New Zealand formations; and three series of deposited archives. The maps comprise three sections; north-east France, Belgium, and western Germany; Gallipoli, Palestine and Egypt; and a small quantity of miscellaneous items. Their scales range from one to ten thousand to one to four thousand.

The General Staff and army administrative papers are miscellaneous in nature, but not without significance. They have been arranged in six series; General Staff memoranda and administrative papers; Army Department records; military camp records; the files of the Regimental Trust Fund Board which commissioned regimental war histories; nominal rolls, lists and casualty registers; and official publications.

The third sub-group contains the war diaries of formations which fought with New Zealand units, including those of armies, army corps, divisions and smaller groupings. The last section of the supplementary archives contains papers of Major H.M.W. Richardson, Sir Stephen Allen, and Sir Alexander Godley. Richardson's and Allen's papers are only miscellaneous oddments, but Godley's are a sequence of letterbooks of semi-official and private correspondence covering most of the war. The Marlborough Historical Society transferred the Richardson papers directly to Archives in September 1965. Those of Allen were passed from Army Library in January 1970. Godley's papers were acquired by the War History Branch from Godley himself on the off chance official histories of World War 1 came to be written. They were transferred to Archives with other papers of the branch.

A small number of maps and eight photographs has subsequently been added. They were transferred from the Invercargill Public Library. A list is on file NA 4/1.

NOTE ON THE DISPOSAL OF WAR HISTORY BRANCH RECORDS

August 1967 the branch considered disposing of much of its archives.

1. The photographic collection (with the exception of a few albums of 3NZ Division) was sent to the Photographic Collection of Alexander Turnbull Library.
2. Published material was sent to the General Assembly: a set of war narratives; all UK S. African, Australian and Canadian narratives and drafts; all civil war histories and other spare volumes from the branch's library; and bound volumes of NZEF Times and Kiwi News.
3. Army Headquarters: a set of war narratives, 'The Times' history of the First World War and some booklets; also transferred were the war diaries of NZ Regiment and Air Service Squadron in Malaya.
4. A quantity of spare maps was sent to the Geography Department University of Otago.

The following were transferred to National Archives at the time: master set of war narratives; the Freyberg papers; translations of German documents; casualty lists and citations; and marked maps of battle areas.
