UChicago Architecture Tour

Join docents from the Chicago Architecture Center as they explore The University of Chicago's rich history and breadth of architectural styles across campus.

Biological Sciences Learning Center:

Explore the Donnelley Biological Sciences Learning Center and its interactive teaching laboratories, learning spaces, and specialized research facilities.

Calvert House Catholic Center

Check out this Newman Center, a Catholic home for the UChicago community providing sacraments, prayer, worship, and spiritual formation.

Carillon Tower

Climb the 271-step spiral staircase for a guided tour through the chapel's attic catwalks, mechanical room, and a demonstration of the famous carillon, followed by a 360-degree view of Chicago from the roof. This tour is not recommended for anyone who may be afraid of heights or claustrophobic.

Center for Identity + Inclusion:

Learn about the Center for Identity + Inclusion and the role it plays in fostering diverse and inclusive communities at UChicago.

Cochrane-Woods Art Center Architecture Studio

Visit the architecture studio at the Cochrane-Woods Art Center to see where students draw, build, and test ideas, while learning how the Architecture Studies program connects history and theory courses with hands-on studio classes.

Coffee Shop Tour:

Sample specialty drinks and explore a select 3 out of the 5 iconic student-run coffee shops to get a sneak peek of your future study and lounging spaces.

Fossil Lab

Get up close to the skeletons of a Tyrannosaurus rex, the massive "SuperCroc," and other extraordinary fossils at Washington Park's new Fossil Lab.

Frederick C. Robie House

Discover the house Frank Lloyd Wright described as "a cornerstone of modern architecture" on this guided tour and see why UNESCO World Heritage listed the site as a masterpiece.

Hanna Holborn Gray Special Collections Research Center

Get a sneak preview of the artist's books featured in a Fall 2027 exhibition. Join student curators to see, handle, and learn about books made as artworks—from cut-up comics, a bag of flour, colored plastics, and other strange materials!

The Institute for the Study of Ancient Cultures:

Experience the ancient world at the Institute for the Study of Ancient Cultures, home to an extensive collection of artifacts from Near Eastern civilizations.

Kersten Physics Teaching Center

Stroll through the Kersten Physics Teaching Center to view the many teaching facilities and labs of UChicago's Physics Department.

Logan Center for the Arts:

Immerse in UChicago's artistic hub for arts and innovation at the Logan Center for the Arts and discover the programs, events, and collaborative spaces that are available for students.

Media Arts, Data, and Design Center:

Check out the Media Arts, Data, and Design Center (MADD), a collaborative learning space, which houses the Hack Arts Lab, the Weston Game Lab, and the Computer Science Instructional Laboratory.

Newberger Hillel Center

Learn about UChicago Hillel, an intellectual and cultural center for Jewish life, learning, and traditions on campus.

Polsky Center for Entrepreneurship and Innovation

Check out the Polsky Exchange, a startup incubator featuring work and meeting spaces, a Small Business Development Center, and programs to help launch your latest venture. This tour includes shuttle transportation to and from the facility.

Pritzker School of Molecular Engineering:

Learn about the undergraduate molecular engineering program while touring the William Eckhardt Research Center and the Pritzker Nanofabrication Facilities.

Ratner Athletic Center:

Discover the fitness offerings available to UChicago students at the Ratner Athletic Center, which boasts a 50-meter swimming pool, basketball courts, fitness classes, and an array of workout equipment.

Regenstein Library:

Join a tour of the Joseph Regenstein Library, an excellent study spot and home to over 4.5 million printed volumes.
