## Your personal luggage checklist

Your cruise is fast approaching and now it's time to play "I'm going on a trip, and taking with me...". But what do you actually need to pack for a cruise anyway? We'll show you which things you definitely need to make room for in your suitcase and which can stay at home:



### Hand luggage

- Valid identity document & visa if required.**
- Travel documents + cruise ticket:** Download from the [Mein Schiff® portal](#). Print out luggage tags.
- Means of payment:** EC or credit card, possibly cash in local currency.
- Health insurance card**
- Private health insurance:** Remember to bring proof of this.
- Important medicines:** Please note the import regulations.
- Driving licence:** For private rental car bookings. The ship is steered by our captain, of course.
- Vaccination pass:** If required.
- Important contact numbers:** Your bank/credit institutes and insurances.
- For flights:** transparent, resealable 1-litre plastic bag for cosmetics/liquids. (Containers max. 100 ml in size)
- Swimwear and a change of clothes:** For your first hours on board.
- Reading glasses & reading material**
- Mobile phone & charger:** Before you even start your holiday, we invite you to download our [Mein Schiff® app](#).
- Headphones:** For some music in your ears, e.g. "Große Freiheit" by James Last & Unheilig.
- Addresses for your holiday post:** You'll find the perfect postcards on board.



### Tips for packing your suitcase

- Dress comfortably:** there's no formal dress code on board.
- Jacket:** Sometimes it can get a little windy on the outer decks.
- Shoes:** Pack comfortable pairs for daytime, sporty options for your shore adventures, and elegant styles for evenings on board.
- Swimwear:** On board there is a 25-metre pool and heated whirlpools.
- Sportswear:** Fitness & active excursion. You don't just sweat in the sauna.

- Sun protection & sunglasses:** The sunlight at sea is stronger than it is on land.
- Beach bag or backpack:** For even more time at sea & many tours of discovery.
- Headwear:** We recommend hats and caps both in summer and in winter.
- If the sea is getting a little stormy:** Sea sickness tablets or ginger can help. Your local pharmacy will be happy to advise you.
- Hair straightener and other stylers:** Or visit our hairdresser's salon 'Hair Spa On Sea' on board.



**More space in your suitcase:** Hand towels, bath towels, bathrobe and hair dryer are already provided in your cabin. You can also find shower gel, shampoo & conditioner in every bathroom.

**Our laundry service on board:** So you can have less changes of clothes and more space for souvenirs.

**Weight of your suitcase:** On board there is no weight restriction for your suitcase. For air travel, the airline's regulations apply.



**Travelling with the whole family: We look forward to seeing you & your little ones.**

- Nappies (Pampers):** Please remember to pack enough of them. They are not available to purchase on board.
- Baby food:** In our bars & restaurants we warm up bottles and jars you've brought with you. Unfortunately we cannot lend you a steriliser on board.
- Baby bath & nappy pail:** These can be borrowed free of charge from Reception.
- Adjustable high chairs:** Are available in all restaurants and bars.
- Baby monitor & baby cot:** Are available free of charge. Our recommendation: Reserve these items in advance (limited availability). Unfortunately we don't have fall-out protection available.
- Pushchair:** pushchairs, strollers etc. must be stored inside the cabin and not along the corridor. You can find even more tips for a perfect family holiday on board on our [website](#).
