

# **DIY Lizard Bead Keychain**



### **Gather supplies**

- String or cord
- Keychain ring
- Scissors
- Black marker • Pony beads (light green, dark green, black, white)



Tape the clasp to the table so strings don't tangle. Separate strings. With one green bead, thread the right string through, followed by left string. Pull them tight to push beads up to the knot at keyring.



To create legs, thread the the cord through five beads then thread back through just two. Adjust the beads as you tighten.



## **Get started**

Cut the string to be about 36-42" long. Fold string in half, creating a loop, and bring ends together. Bring the loop through the keychain clasp and pull to create slipknot.




## **Keep going**

Following the image at the right, continue the pattern threading beads and pulling each row tight to the previous.



After you've added the tail beads, tie a knot and cut the excess. Use your marker and add eyes to the white beads.



Ask an adult to help with this project.
