DIY Tambourine

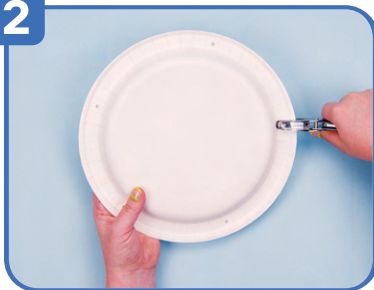
1



Gather supplies

- Two small paper plates (6" or 7")
- Paint
- Paint brushes
- Hole punch
- Pencil
- Five jingle bells ($\frac{3}{4}$ " or 1")
- Twist ties
- Glue
- Things to decorate your tambourine with: stickers, craft foam shapes, sequins, glitter glue, etc.

Mark and punch

Using a pencil, draw five evenly-spaced marks along the edge of the plate. Use the hole punch and punch out each mark.

Align and punch more

Using the punched plate as a template, trace each hole onto the second plate and punch out each mark. (The holes should match up on each plate.)

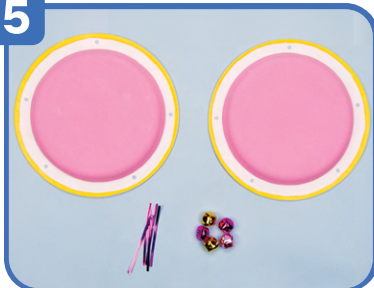

Paint

Use your imagination and paint the plates in your favorite colors. Let the paint dry.

Prepare the bells

String the jingle bells through the middle of each twist tie and loop in through the holes of one plate. Continue for all five bells.

6



Connect

Align the two plates face-to-face with the holes you punched earlier. Use the twist ties and the bells to connect the plates together.

7



Decorate and play

Decorate your tambourine using stickers and any other cutouts you can imagine.
