Squirrely Science

The Sandy Twister

*Adult supervision required

SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Jar with lid
- Hand sanitizer
- Water
- Food coloring

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Fill the jar with water, leaving approx.2 inches free at top.
- 2. Add a squirt of hand sanitizer.
- **3.** Add 3-4 drops of food coloring.
- **4.** Place the lid on top and swirl the jar in a circle as quickly as possible.
- 5. Watch a twister form!



A tornado is a large, rotating column of air that goes from a thundercloud to the ground, forming only in thunderstorms with powerful winds. When warm, humid air rises and cool air falls, it can create spinning air currents inside the clouds. If the air changes direction and speed, it could form a wide, tall, tube of spinning clouds, called a vortex.

We created our own vortex by swirling the liquid in the jar, so we can see the motion of a tornado. Do some experiments with your twister. What happens with more or less water in the jar? What happens if you swirl the jar faster or slower? Did your vortex touch both the top and bottom of the jar? Observe how your twister ends!
















Sea (and Land!) Pals


