

Let's Make It:

Swapped DIY Planter



Supplies:

- Scissors
- Acrylic paint
- Paint brush
- Plastic bottle
- Marker
- Hot glue (low-temp)



Have an adult help
with this project

Gather your supplies! Make sure your bottle is clean and dry.

2



Look at your bottle and imagine the bird it could become. Use a marker to draw the bird's head shape and map out where you will cut. Cut along the perimeter.

3



Poke a few small holes in the bottom so water can drain out. Save any larger scraps you cut away.

TIP:

For poking holes, use the tip of a hot glue gun

4



Paint a base coat. Apply two coats of paint, letting each coat dry before adding the next.

5



Use your plastic scraps to cut simple bird features, like a beak or feathers. Bend or shape the pieces however you like.

6



Using the lowest temperature setting, hot glue the features onto your bird.

7



Paint the eyes, beak, and feathers, and add any other decorations you want.

8



Once dry, fill with soil, add your plant or seeds, and water lightly. Set it in a sunny spot to grow.
