

**KPop: Demon Hunters Charm** 

Let's learn two kinds of Korean knots: the Dorae (doh·leh) Knot and the Saengjjok (seyng·joak) Knot! The Korean art of knotting is called maedeup (meh·doop).

## NORIGAE (noh·ree·gae)

Rumi, Mira, and Zoey all wear norigae, a traditional Korean accessory and good-luck charm. People decorate their norigae with ornaments and tassels, just like Zoey did with her favorite animal

— a turtle!



- Cord (48") Here we use a 3 mm cord. Start by learning on a 4 or 5 mm cord
- ☐ **Beads and charms** Just make sure they'll fit on your cord
- Patience Learning maedeup takes time and practice








A and B in a full circle — just

like a hula hoop!













## **SAENGJJOK KNOT**
































Put your thumb, pointer finger, and middle finger through the leaves of the clover.
