

# Spellbound Flink Sock Stuffie



## Gather Supplies

- Purple sock
- Stuffing
- Purple thread
- Fabric glue
- Needle
- Black pen
- Scissors
- Black, white, purple felt



## 2a Draw the Head

Turn the sock inside out. On the shorter side of the sock, above the heel, draw a curve to outline the head.



## 2b Sew the Head

Use thread to sew along the curve you just drew.



## 2c Trim the Head

Carefully cut just above the line just sewn.



## 3 Trim the Sock

Cut off the toe section of the sock, and flip it right side out.



## 4 Add Stuffing

Take a handful of stuffing and shape it into a ball. Place it at the top of the sock for the head. Use a smaller handful for the body and put it below the head. Adjust the stuffing inside the sock until you're happy with the shape.



## 5 Close the Openings

Sew a running stitch around the open edge of the sock until you reach the other side. Pull the thread tight, scrunch the extra fabric at the bottom, and tuck the seams inside. Stitch the bottom of the sock flat and secure it with a knot.



Ask an adult to help with this project.

**Make Ears and Arms**

Cut four small circles from the leftover sock fabric to form the ears and arms. Fold each circle in half and sew them shut.

7



**Attach Ears**

With the thread still attached, sew one ear to the top of the head. Repeat for the other ear.

8



**Attach Arms**

Repeat the same process as the ears by sewing one arm to each side of Flink's body.

9



**Create Eyes**

To make the eyes, cut circles from white, purple, and black felt, making each circle smaller than the last. Using fabric glue, attach them together and on to Flink's face.

10



**Create Mouth and Teeth**

Cut a mouth shape out of black felt, and teeth out of white felt. Using fabric glue, attach them to Flink's face.

**Now you have  
your own little  
sidekick Flink!**
