

# Nimona Shark Backpack

### Gather supplies

- Backpack
- Scrap paper for a template (like from a shopping bag)
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Red, white, and pink felt
- Tacky glue
- Paintbrush and small bowl
- 2 large black buttons
- Hot glue (or a needle and thread)

### Make a template

Use the scrap paper and pencil to trace the mouth area on your backpack top to make a template. Cut it out and trace it onto the red felt. Cut out a red mouth.

### Cut the teeth

Cut a triangle out of the scrap paper to the size of tooth you would like and trace it onto white felt. Cut out enough teeth to fill your mouth. (We used 24!)

### Glue

Squeeze the tacky glue into a little bowl. Use a paintbrush to coat the backs of the teeth with glue and adhere them to the mouth.

### Make some fins

Draw a fin shape onto the scrap paper. (Add about 1/4" to the flat side to allow room for gluing the fin to the backpack.) Cut out the shape to make a template. Trace two fin shapes onto the pink felt and cut them out.

### Finally

Attach the mouth, fins, and button eyes to the backpack: Brush tacky glue to the back of the mouth and adhere it to the front pocket. Use tacky glue or hot glue to attach the fins to the sides of the backpack. Attach the eyes with hot glue or sew them on with a needle and thread.
