FREE CROCHET PATTERN

Ripple Remix Scarf



TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Liz Salazar for Premier Yarns®

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 12”

Length: 102”

GAUGE:

14 sts x 7 rows = 4” in patt

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

[Premier® Yarns Puzzle® Solids \(100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m\)](#)

- C1: 2162-07 Navy – 2 balls
- C2: 2162-06 Purple – 2 skeins

HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- [US Size J-10 \(6 mm\) or size needed to obtain gauge](#)
- [Tapestry needle](#)

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chain, single crochet, and double crochet stitches.
- Increases and decreases.
- Changing colors.

PATTERN NOTES

This generously sized scarf is worked flat from end to end. The classic ripple stitch pattern is fun and addictive to work! When changing colors, work up to the final pull-through of the last stitch of the row, then complete the stitch with the new color. Cut the old color and weave in ends at each color change.

SCARF

With C1, ch 43.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 3 ch, *3 sc in next ch, sc in next 4 ch, sk next 2 ch, sc in next 4 ch; rep from * 2 more times, 3 sc in next ch, sc in last 4 ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, *3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * 2 more times, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, sk next sc, sc in last sc, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next sc, dc in next 3 sc, *3 dc in next sc, dc in next 4 sc, sk next 2 sc, dc in next 4 sc; rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in next sc, dc in next 3 sc, sk next sc, dc in last sc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3 (counts as dc), sk next dc, dc in next 3 dc, *3 dc in next dc, dc in next 4 dc, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 4 dc; rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in next dc, dc in next 3 dc, sk next dc, dc in last dc, switching to C2 on last pull-through, turn. Cut C1.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in 1st sc, sk next sc, sc in next 3 sc, *3 sc in next sc, sc in next 4 sc, sk next 2 sc, sc in next 4 sc; rep from * 2 more times, 3 sc in next sc, sc in next 3 sc, sk next sc, sc in last sc, ch 1, turn.

Rows 6-8: With C2, rep Rows 2-4, switching to C1 on last pull-through, turn. Cut C2.

Rows 9-12: With C1, rep Row 5, then rep Rows 2-4, switching to C2 on last pull-through.

Rep Rows 5-8 until Scarf measures 102”.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block lightly.
