Ocean Shore Blanket

FREE CROCHET PATTERN

Ocean Shore Blanket



TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Liz Salazar for Premier® Yarns

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 40¼”

Length: 56”

GAUGE:

15 hbhdc x 13 rows = 4” with 1 strand each of MC and CC held together

Save time, check your gauge.

HOOK & NOTIONS:

- US Size H-8 (5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle, 7” piece of cardboard

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Colorfusion DK (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 325yds/298m)

- MC: 1196-06 Seaside – 9 balls

Premier® Yarns Trinket™ (75% Acrylic, 20% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m)

- CC: 2161-08 Tiger’s Eye – 7 balls

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and herringbone half double crochet stitches.
- Back and front post double crochet stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Herringbone Half Double Crochet (hbhdc): Yo, insert hook into indicated st/sp, pull up loop through top of st and first loop on hook, yo pull through 2 loops on hook.

PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! One strand each of Trinket and Colorfusion DK are held together throughout this project. Blanket is worked flat from end to end.

BLANKET

Holding 1 strand of MC and 1 strand of CC together, ch 152.

Row 1: Working in back bumps of chs, **hbhdc** in 3rd ch from hook (2 skipped chs count as **hbhdc**) and in each ch across, turn – 151 **hbhdc**.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 2 (counts as **hbhdc** throughout), **hbhdc** in next 4 sts, *fpdc in next 2 sts, **hbhdc** in next 9 sts, fpdc in next 4 sts, **hbhdc** in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, **hbhdc** in last 2 sts, turn.

Row 3 (WS): Ch 2, **hbhdc** in next 4 sts, *bpdc in next 2 sts, **hbhdc** in next 9 sts, bpdc in next 4 sts, **hbhdc** in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, **hbhdc** in last 2 sts, turn.

Rep Rows 2-3 until Blanket measures 56”.

FINISHING

TASSELS (MAKE 16)

Wrap CC held together with MC around cardboard 18 times. Cut three 12” strands of CC. Thread 2 pieces into tapestry needle and pass through one end of wrapped yarn. Tie one piece in a knot to secure this end. Leave the other piece untied to attach to Blanket. Cut open the opposite end, freeing the tassel from the cardboard. Wrap the 3rd piece around the entire tassel several times approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ ” below the tied end. Trim ends evenly to approximately $3\frac{1}{2}$ ”. Beginning on last row worked, use untied strand of yarn to attach first Tassel to corner edge, attach next 7 Tassels, evenly spacing them about $5\frac{3}{4}$ ” apart. The 8th Tassel should land on opposite corner edge. Rep steps for rem 8 Tassels on beg-ch edge of first row worked.

Fasten off. Weave in ends.
