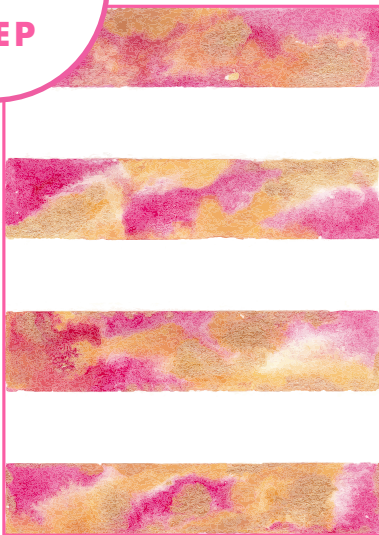
STEP



Sketch the design and layout of the lettering + ink splatter. Feel free to use this design as a practice sheet for the lettering

STEP



PAINT + REPEAT

- Dip your paintbrush in water first and then paint a thin layer of water on the paper. We will be using the wet-on-wet technique here.
- The wet-on-wet technique is basically to paint with water first and then add the pigments afterwards
- After the thin layer of water has been painted on the paper, dip your paintbrush in one of the inks and drop that pigment in the area that has water. This will allow the pigment to spread the minute it touches the water.
- Continue this process by using other ink colors. Remember to rinse your paintbrush in water before using another ink color to avoid the colors getting mixed.

APPLY PAINTER'S TAPE

- The area that has the painter's tape will be the section for the lettering and the areas without the tape is for the wash background

- Finish off the artwork by removing the tape and hand letter a fun quote!
