Spring Shades Scarf



TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Liz Salazar for Premier® Yarns

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 11¼”

Length: 90”

GAUGE:

5 v-sts x 12 rows = 4” in patt with 1 strand of each yarn held together **Save time, check your gauge.**

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns *Anti-Pilling Everyday*®
Worsted Gradient (100% Anti-Pilling
Acrylic, 20% Nylon; 7oz/200g,
360yds/330m)

- 2115-01 Green Tones – 2 balls

Premier® Yarns *Trinket*™ (75% Acrylic,
20% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m)

- 2161-01 Citrine - 2 balls

HOOK & NOTIONS:

- US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle, 10” piece of cardboard

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chain and half double crochet stitches.
- Adding fringe.

STITCH GUIDE

Half Double Crochet V-Stitch (v-st): [hdc, ch 2, hdc] in indicated ch/sp.

PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! One strand each of Trinket and Anti-Pilling Everyday Worsted Gradient are held together throughout this project. The Scarf is worked flat from end to end. When joining a new ball of gradient yarn, join where the color tones match for best results.

SCARF

Holding 1 strand of each yarn together, ch 47.

Row 1: V-st in 5th ch from hook (first 2 skipped chs count as hdc) *sk 2 ch, **v-st** in next ch; rep from * to last 3 ch, sk 2 ch, hdc in last ch, turn – 14 **v-sts**.

Row 2: Ch 2 (counts as hdc throughout), **v-st** in ch-2 sp of each **v-st** to last hdc, hdc in last hdc, turn.

Rep Row 2 until Scarf meas 90". Fasten off, weave in ends.

FINISHING

FRINGE

Wrap Trinket only around cardboard 10 times. Cut open one end, freeing the yarn from the cardboard and creating a group of 10 – 20" strands. Holding 10 strands together, attach Fringe through the ch-2 sp of any **v-st** on last row worked. Rep the process for every **v-st** on first row worked. Trim Fringe evenly.
