

Cable Scarf

#### SIZE

One Size

#### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 9" Length: 65"

#### **MATERIALS**

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling® Everyday® Bamboo Chunky (80% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 20% Rayon from Bamboo; 3.5oz/100g, 131yds/120m)

• 1085-23 Boysenberry - 6 balls **Hook:** US Size K-10.5 (6.5 mm) *or size needed* 

to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

10 sc x 12 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Front post double crochet and treble crochet stitches.
- Working Cables.
- Adding fringe.

#### STITCH GUIDE

**Fpdc (Front Post Double Crochet):** Yo, insert hk from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 lps on hk] twice.

**Fptr (Front Post Treble Crochet):** Yo twice, insert hk from front to back to front around the post of the st and draw yarn through, [yo and draw through 2 lps on hk] three times.

#### CABLE 1

Working over next 4 sts: sk 2 sts, **Fptr** on next 2 sts 2 rows below, working over 2 sts just made, **Fptr** on skipped 2 sts 2 rows below.

#### CABLE 2

Working over next 4 sts: **Fptr** on next 2 sts 2 rows below, working behind 2 sts just made (on right side), **Fptr** on skipped 2 sts 2 rows below.

#### **PATTERN NOTES**

The Scarf is worked in rows end to end and completed with fringe on each end. When working Row 8, you will be closing the gap between the last 2 rows by joining the stitches together.

#### **SCARF**

Ch 26.

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hk and in each ch across, turn - 25 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, \***Fpdc** in next 8 sts, sc in next 3 sts, rep from \* across, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, \*Cable 1, Cable 2, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, \*working through Rows 6 and 7 together as one st, sc in next 8 sts, sc in next 3 sts; rep from \* across, turn

**Row 9**: Ch 1, sc in next 3 sts, \***Fpdc** in next 8 sts 2 rows below, sc in next 3 sts, rep from \* across, turn.

Rep Rows 6-9 until Scarf meas 64".

**Last 4 Rows:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn. Fasten off.

# project continued

## **FINISHING**

Cut 28 - 10" lengths of yarn. Holding 2 strands together, add fringe in 14 sts evenly across end of Scarf. Trim. Rep on opposite end.

Block gently.

Weave in ends.
