



## Paloma Pullover

### SIZES

12 mos (2, 4, 6, 8, 10) years

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Chest:** 19¼ (21½, 23½, 30, 31¼, 33½)''

**Length:** 13¼ (15½, 17½, 19¼, 20¼, 20¾)''

### MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Sweet Roll® Fruits** (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 174yds/160m)

- 2056-06 Pink Grapefruit – 3 (3, 4, 5, 5, 6) cakes

**Needle:** US Size 8 (5 mm) and US Size 9 (5.5 mm) knitting needles *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, locking stitch marker, stitch holder or waste yarn, cable needle

### GAUGE

17 sts x 23 rows = 4'' in St st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Knit and Purl Stitches
- Cabling
- Seaming
- Kfb Increases
- K2tog and Ssk Decreases

### STITCH GUIDE

**2x2 Rib** (multiple of 4 sts)

**Row 1:** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to end.

Rep Row 1 for patt.

**Cable Panel** (panel of 12 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** P2, k8, p2.

**Row 2 (WS):** k2, p8, p2.

**Row 3:** P2, 4/4LC, p2.

**WS Rows 4, 6, 8, 10:** Work as for Row 2.

**RS Rows 5, 7, 9:** Work as for Row 1.

Rep Rows 1-10 for patt.

**4/4LC (4/4 Left Cross):** Slip 4 sts onto cable needle and hold in front, k4, k4 from cable needle.

### PATTERN NOTES

This Pullover is worked from the bottom up in pieces and seamed.

### PULLOVER

#### Back

With smaller needle, cast on 44 (48, 52, 56, 60, 64) sts, work even in **2x2 Rib** until piece meas 1½ (1½, 2, 2, 2, 2)''.

Switch to larger needle.

**Setup Row 1 (RS):** K4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8), work **Cable Panel** (start at Row 1) over next 12 sts, k12 (16, 16, 20, 20, 24), work **Cable Panel** (start at Row 1) over next 12 sts, k4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8).

**Setup Row 2 (WS):** P4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8), work **Cable Panel** over next 12 sts, p12 (16, 16, 20, 20, 24), work **Cable Panel** over next 12 sts, p4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8).

Work even in est'd patt, until piece meas 13¼ (15½, 17½, 19¼, 20¼, 20¾)'' from cast-on edge, bind off sts.

#### Front

With smaller needle, cast on 44 (48, 52, 56, 60, 64) sts, work even in **2x2 Rib** until piece meas 1½ (1½, 2, 2, 2, 2)''.

Switch to larger needle.

**Setup Row 1 (RS):** K4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8), work **Cable Panel** (start at Row 1) over next 12 sts, k12 (16, 16, 20, 20, 24), work **Cable Panel** (start at Row 1) over next 12 sts, k4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8).

## project continued

**Setup Row 2 (WS):** P4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8), work **Cable Panel** over next 12 sts, p12 (16, 16, 20, 20, 24),

work **Cable Panel** over next 12 sts, p4 (4, 6, 6, 8, 8).  
Work even in est'd patt, until piece meas 11¼ (14, 15½, 17, 18, 18½)" from cast-on edge, end having just worked a WS row.

### Neck Shaping

*(Note: Maintain Cable Panels in pattern as much as possible while shaping the neck.)*

**Row 1 (RS):** Work 16 (18, 20, 22, 24, 25) sts in est'd patt (left shoulder sts), bind off 12 (12, 12, 12, 14, 14) sts, work in patt to end, place left shoulder sts on stitch holder or waste yarn.

**Row 2 (WS):** Work even in patt.

**Dec Row (RS):** K1, ssk, work in patt to end — 1 st dec'd.

**Next Row:** Work even in patt.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 3, 3, 2, 3) more times — 2 (2, 3, 3, 2, 3) sts dec'd, 13 (15, 16, 18, 21) sts rem.  
Work 0 (0, 2, 2, 4, 4) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

Place held sts on working needle and with RS facing, join yarn.

**Dec Row (RS):** Work in patt to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 — 1 st dec'd.

**Next Row:** Work even in patt.

Rep last 2 rows 2 (2, 3, 3, 2, 3) more times — 2 (2, 3, 3, 2, 3) sts dec'd, 13 (15, 16, 18, 21) sts rem.  
Work 0 (0, 2, 2, 4, 4) rows even in patt, bind off sts.

### Sleeves (Make 2)

With smaller needle, cast on 32 (32, 32, 36, 36, 36) sts, work even in **2x2 Rib** until piece meas 1½ (1½, 2, 2, 2, 2)". Switch to larger needle, work 6 (4, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows even in St st.

**Inc Row (RS):** K1, kfb, knit to last 3 sts, kfb, k1 — 2 sts inc'd.

**All other rows:** Work even in patt.

Rep Inc Row every RS row 1 (0, 8, 4, 2, 1, 5) more times, and then every other RS row 5 (8, 6, 10, 13, 15) times — 12 (16, 28, 28, 30, 32) sts inc'd, 46 (54, 60, 66, 72, 74) sts total.

If necessary, work even in patt until Sleeve meas 8½ (10, 11¼, 12¼, 14, 15¼)" from cast-on edge, bind off sts.

### FINISHING

Sew one shoulder seam.

### Neck Edging

With RS facing and smaller needles, pick up and knit 56 (56, 64, 64, 68, 72) sts along neck opening. Work even in **2x2 Rib** for 1". Loosely bind off in rib.

Place locking marker at the top center of each Sleeve. Use marker to align center of Sleeve with shoulder seam, sew Sleeves along the edge of Front and Back. Seam the Front and Back and Sleeves.

Weave in ends.

<b>dec('d)</b>	decrease(d)
<b>est'd</b>	established
<b>inc('d)</b>	increase(d)
<b>k</b>	knit
<b>kfb</b>	knit into the front and back of the next st (1 st inc'd)
<b>k2tog</b>	knit 2 sts together (1 st dec'd)
<b>meas</b>	measures
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>patt</b>	pattern
<b>rem</b>	remain(ing)
<b>rep</b>	repeat(ing)
<b>RS</b>	right side
<b>ssk</b>	slip slip knit (1 st dec'd)
<b>st(s)</b>	stitch(es)
<b>St st</b>	Stockinette stitch: knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows
<b>WS</b>	wrong side
