# **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

#### **SIZES**

About 10 in. (25.5 cm) tall

#### **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA® (Art. #215)
  #101 Pink 1 ball (A)
  #140 Dusty Pink 1 ball (B)
  #153 Black 1 ball (C)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers

#100 White 1 ball (D)

• LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle



# **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

Crochet hook size F-5 (3.75 mm) Black embroidery floss Fiberfill stuffing

# **GAUGE**

18 sc + 20 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm). BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

#### STITCH EXPLANATION

sc2tog (sc 2 sts together) (Insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

# **TECHNIQUE EXPLANATION**

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around index finger. Insert hook into ring on finger, yarn over and draw up a loop. Carefully slip ring from finger and work the sts of Rnd 1 into the ring.

#### **NOTES**

- 1. Flamingo is worked in 10 separate pieces: Head/Body, 2 Cheeks, 2 Wings, 2 Legs, 2 Feet, and a Beak.
- 2. All pieces are worked in continuous rnds (spiral). Do not join last st of rnds to first st with a sl st. Do not turn at beg of rnds.
- 3. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Fasten off old color.

### **SAFETY NOTE**

If Flamingo is intended for a baby or child, be certain that all pieces have been very securely sewn together. Don't leave a baby or child unattended with the Flamingo!

# **HEAD/BODY**

#### Head

With A, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: Work 2 sc in each st around – you will have 12 sc in this rnd.

**Rnd 3:** \* Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

Rnd 4: \* Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** \* Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

Rnd 6: Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 7:** \* Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

Rnds 8 and 9: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 10: \* Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

**Rnd 11:** \* Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 48 sc.

**Rnd 12:** \* Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st; rep from \* around – 54 sc.

Rnds 13-15: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 16: \* Sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 48 sc.

Rnd 17: \* Sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 42 sc.

Begin stuffing piece and continue stuffing until piece is complete.

**Rnd 18:** \* Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

**Rnd 19:** \* Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

Rnd 20: \* Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

Rnd 21: \* Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 18 sc.

Rnds 22-25: Sc in each st around.

Remove end of rnd marker.

# **Body**

Rnd 26: SI st in next st, ch 12 (for back), 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in next 10 ch; working in sts of Rnd 25, sc in next 18 sts; working along opposite side of back chain, sc in next 10 ch, 2 sc in last ch – 42 sc.

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Rnd 27: Sc in next 2 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 5 times, sc in next 18 sts, (2 sc in next st, sc in next st) 5 times, sc in last 2 sts – 52 sc.

Rnds 28-30: Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 31:** Sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 16 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog – 46 sc.

**Rnd 32:** Sc in next 14 sts, (sc2tog, sc in next 14 sts) twice – 44 sc.

Rnd 33: Sc in next 13 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 14 sts, sc2tog, sc in last 13 sts – 42 sc.

Rnd 34: \* Sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 36 sc.

Rnd 35: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 36: \* Sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 30 sc.

Rnd 37: \* Sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 24 sc.

Rnd 38: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 39: \* Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 16 sc.

Rnd 40: Sc2tog around – 8 sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through top of sts of last rnd. Pull tail to close opening and knot securely.

# CHEEKS (make 2)

With B, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; join with sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Cheek to Head.

#### **BEAK**

With C, beg at tip of Beak, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 5 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: Work 2 hdc in next st, sc in next 4 sts – 6 sts (2 hdc and 4 sc).

Rnds 3-6: Work 2 hdc in next st, sc in each st around; change to D in last st of Rnd 6 - 10 sts (2 hdc and 8 sc) in Rnd 6.

Cut C. Work remainder of piece with D only.

Rnd 7: Sc in each st around.

Rnd 8: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Beak to Head.

# LEGS (make 2)

With B, beg at ankle, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnds 2-10: Sc in each st around.

#### Knee

**Rnd 11:** (Sc in next st, 2 sc in next st) 3 times - 9 sc.

Rnd 12: Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 13:** (Sc in next st, sc2tog) 3 times -6 sc.

Rnds 14-18: Sc in each st around.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Legs to Body.

# FEET (make 2)

With B, leaving a long beg tail for sewing Foot to Leg, and beginning at ankle, make a magic ring.

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 8 sc.

**Rnd 3:** (Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice -10 sc.

Rnd 4: Sc in each st around.

Do not stuff Foot.

**Rnd 5:** Hold edges of last rnd together, matching 5 sts along each of 2 edges; working through both thicknesses, sc in next 5 sts.

Fasten off.

# WINGS (make 2)

With B, make a magic ring.

Lower Section (worked in rnds)

**Rnd 1:** Work 6 sc in ring; do not join, work in continuous rnds (spiral).

Place marker in last st made to indicate end of rnd. Move marker up as each rnd is completed.

Gently but firmly, pull tail to tighten center of ring.

Rnd 2: (Sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 8 sc.

Rnd 3: (Sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 10 sc.

**Rnd 4:** (Sc in next 4 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice -12 sc.

Rnd 5: (Sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 14 sc.

Rnd 6: (Sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice – 16 sc.

**Rnd 7:** (Sc in next 7 sts, 2 sc in next st) twice -18 sc.

Rnds 8 and 9: Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 10:** \* Sc in next st, sc2tog; rep from \* around – 12 sc.

**Rnd 11:** (Sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog) 3 times – 9 sc.

Do not stuff Wing.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing Wing to Body.

## **FINISHING**

Using photograph as a guide and yarn tails still attached to pieces whenever possible, assemble Flamingo as follows:

With D, sew Beak to Head between Rnds 10 and 14.

With black embroidery floss, embroider eyes between Rnds 8 and 11, 8 sts apart.

With B, sew Cheeks between Rnds 12 and 15.

With B, sew Wings to side of Body, around Rnd 29.

With B, sew Feet to Legs.

With B, sew Legs to bottom of Body.

Weave in ends.
