# Cozy Pocket Scarf



**TYPE:** Crochet

By Premier Yarns® Design Team

## **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**

**Width:** 8"

**Length:** 58"

**Pocket depth:** 10"

## **GAUGE:**

16 sts x 8 rows = 4" in patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## **MATERIALS:**

**Premier® Yarns Puzzle® Solids (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)**

- 2162-02 Rust – 2 balls

## **HOOKS & NOTIONS:**

- **US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge**
- **Tapestry needle**

## **SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:**

- Chain, single crochet, and double crochet stitches.
- Front and back post double crochet stitches.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.

## PATTERN NOTES

Scarf is made in one panel with ends folded up and sewn on sides to create Pockets.

### SCARF

Ch 31.

**Row 1 (RS):** Sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each rem ch across, turn – 30 sc.

**Row 2 (WS):** Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), sc in same st, \*fpdc around next st, bpdc around next st; rep from \* to last sc, sc in last st, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in same st, \*bpdc around next st, fpdc around next st; rep from \* to last sc, sc in last sc, turn.

**Row 4:** Rep Row 2.

**Row 5:** Rep Row 3.

**Rows 6-7:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sc in next 2 sts, \*ch 2, sk 2 sts, sc in next 2 sts; rep from \* across, turn.

**Row 9:** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), sk next sc, \*4 dc in next ch-2 sp\*\*, sk next 2 sc; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ending last rep at \*\*, sk next sc, dc in last sc, turn – 2 dc and 7 4-dc groups.

**Row 10 (WS):** Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in sp bef first 4-dc group, \*ch 2, sc in sp bet next two 4-dc groups; rep from \* to last 4-dc group, ch 2, sc in sp bet last 4-dc group and last dc, sc in last dc, turn – 10 sc and 7 4-dc groups.

**Row 11 (RS):** Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), sk next sc, \*4 dc in next ch-2 sp\*\*, sk next sc; rep from \* to last 2 sts, ending last rep at \*\*, sk next sc, dc in last sc, turn – 2 dc and 7 4-dc groups.

Rep Rows 10 and 11 until Scarf is 78", end having just worked a Row 10.

### Last 8 Rows

**Row 1:** Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, \*3 sc in next ch-2 sp, sc in next sc; rep from \* to last sc, sc in last sc, turn – 31 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*fpdc around next st, bpdc in next st; rep from \* to last sc, sc in last sc, turn.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in first sc, \*bpdc around next st, fpdc in next st; rep from \* across, ending with sc in last sc, turn.

**Row 5:** Rep Rows 3.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4.

**Row 7:** Ch 1, sc in each st across, turn.

**Row 8:** Ch 1, sl st in each sc across. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

### POCKETS

Measure 10” from the bottom edge of Scarf and fold upward to create a 10” deep pocket. Using mattress stitch, seam Pocket section at both side edges. Rep on opposite bottom edge of Scarf. Weave in all ends.
